Application Form

Once deemed eligible and have a planned project proposal, you may formally apply for the IMP.

Here is the info you will need to provide:

- Summary of project (incl. existing research background, description, plan, expected benefits of participating in the IMP)
- CV from Applicant
- Proposed Itinerary + Budget
- Short written statements of support from supervisor and from host researcher
- Link to host's research profile or a Short CV from host researcher
